PERFORMANCE/LABS PARTICIPATION

Being a member of the Granite Ridge Band and Colorguard <u>is</u> a commitment to performing. It is expected that ALL members will participate in all scheduled performances and labs, which are worth 100 points each. In order to receive full participation credit, students should utilize the appropriate uniform (which will be provided if needed), music and instrument, as well as participate in an appropriate manner.

DAILY CLASSROOM PARTICIPATION

Students will earn points by putting forth their best effort, and participating each day in an appropriate manner. The classroom participation portion of the grade is worth up to 10 points per week.

SKILLS/TESTS

Students will learn performance fundamentals (such as scales, rhythms, technical exercises, etc.), along with basic concepts in music theory, vocabulary and notation.

CITIZENSHIP

Behavior, general deportment, adherence to rules, policies, and procedures, being prepared for rehearsals and performances. Also includes being in proper uniform or attire during concerts, football games, and parades.

SIGNED DOCUMENTS

Items that must be signed by parents and returned to the band office by a specified deadline.

PERFORMANCE ATTENDANCE EXPECTATIONS

GENERAL ATTENDANCE EXPECTATIONS

Participation in performances is expected of all members of the GR Band. Missing a performance for reasons such as... "I'm being grounded", "I have too much homework", "I didn't feel like going", "I forgot", "My family had a birthday party", etc. won't be considered "excused". Also, please be aware that we do ask our students to remain for a few minutes after each performance to help clean up music stands and percussion equipment.

EXCUSED ABSENCES FROM A PERFORMANCE

A calendar of performances is included in this packet. Please put these dates on your family calendar ASAP, and notify Mr. Vargas within the 1st month of school if you notice any conflicts with the calendar. Of course, it's understandable that occasional conflicts arise for which students are unable to give advance notice (family emergency, illness, etc.). In this case, please send your child with a note the day he/she returns to school. **Absences will only be cleared with a parent-signed note**. It is the student's responsibility to remember to communicate with Mr. Vargas about absences, and to bring a note from home to clear the absence.

EXTRA-CURRICULAR CONFLICTS

Students who participate in more than one GR co-curricular or extra-curricular sport/activity may be allowed to miss all or portions of performances according to the following criteria:

PERFORMANCE vs. PRACTICE = Student will attend the PERFORMANCE;

REHEARSAL vs. GAME = Student will attend the GAME:

PERFORMANCE vs. GAME = Directors/Coaches of each activity will decide which of the two will be the most appropriate for the student to attend, and let the student know where he/she should be.

Treat each other with kindness, both with your words as well as with your actions.


NO HORSEPLAY at any time in the Band room!!

BE READY!

Practice your instrument a little bit every day! **Always have** your **instrument**, **music**, **pencil** & **supplies** at every rehearsal. Get your **instrument repaired quickly** when necessary.

NO FOOD/DRINK IN REHEARSAL!

This includes *candy and gum*!
You may have *bottled water* during rehearsal. *Finish* all snacks *BEFORE entering* the room.

CLARINET/ BASS CL.



- Cleaning swab
- 4 to 6 reeds w/ reed case
 - Cork grease
- Small flathead eyeglasses screwdriver



TRUMPET

- Valve oil
- Slide cream/grease
 - Polishing cloth

FRENCH HORN

- Valve oil
- Slide cream/grease
 - Polishing cloth

TROMBONE

- "Trombotine" or "Slide-O-Mix" slide cream
- Tuning slide cream/grease (different from Trombotine)
 - "Bone bottle" (water spray bottle)
 - Polishing cloth

BARITONE & TUBA

- Valve oil
- Slide cream/grease
 - Polishing cloth

PERCUSSION

- General concert keyboard mallets
 - General concert drum sticks
 - Practice pad
 - Stick bag
